Projects style:

MLA Advanced *(this is the recommended option at your school or library)*

- follows the *MLA Handbook, 7th ed.*

MLA Starter

- simpler forms
- only the most basic citation types available

APA Advanced

- follows the *APA Publication Manual, 6th ed.*

Chicago/Turabian Advanced

- bibliography/notes formatting
- follows Turabian's *A Manual for Writers of Research Papers, Theses, and Dissertations, 7th ed.*

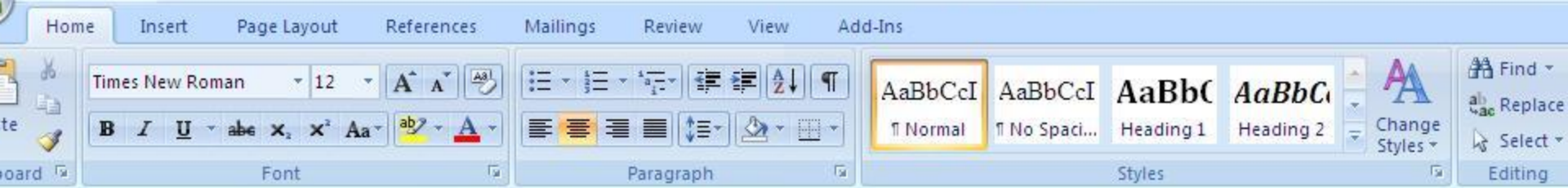
